The Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 (IRA) invests over \$60 billion in critical clean energy, climate and electrification measures and puts the U.S. on path to a 40 percent emissions reduction by 2030. The IRA contains numerous opportunities for municipalities to leverage these dollars to improve the quality of life for residents, reduce their utility costs, and modernize homes and businesses.



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• 10 percent bonus: domestic content requirements

• 10 percent bonus: wind and solar facilities with a maximum net output of less than five MW

• 20 percent bonus: part of a "qualified lowincome residential building project" or "qualified
